- 1. The competition is open to Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents, and holders of valid Student Passes or Work Passes residing in Singapore.
- 2. Piano teachers, professional musicians, and those who derive their principal source of income from public performances are not allowed to participate for the Student, Junior, and Exam Categories.

Registration

- 1. Performance repertoires must be clearly indicated in the Registration Form.
- 2. Sheet music submission is not required.
- 3. Registration fees must be paid in full at the time of registration.
- 4. Registration fees are strictly non-refundable, except in the event of cancellation by the organiser.
- 5. The organiser reserves the right to cancel or combine categories due to unforeseen circumstances. In such cases, a full refund will be provided.

Performance Guidelines

- 1. Participants are expected to wear their best performance attire.
- 2.On the day of the competition, participants must follow the performance order set by the organising committee.
- 3. Late arrivals may result in disqualification at the organiser's discretion.
- 4. Approaching judges before or during the competition is strictly prohibited.
