

- A. One Etude chosen from Chopin, Liszt, Rachmaninoff, Skriabin, Debussy, Stravinsky, Prokofiev, Ligeti;
- B. One or more than one piece, free choice, both Chinese or western pieces are acceptable.
- Duration: Minimum of 6 minutes, maximum of 12 minutes
- 2. International Grand Final @ Xiamen, China

<u>Round 1:</u>

- A. An Etude chosen from Chopin, Liszt, Rachmaninoff, Skriabin, Debussy, Stravinsky, Prokofiev, Ligeti;
- B. One or more than one piece, free choice, both Chinese or western pieces are acceptable.

Duration: Minimum 12 minutes to Maximum 15 minutes

Round 2:

- A. One movement of a multi-movement sonata, chosen from Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven or Schubert;
- B. Two pieces, Free choices, both Chinese or western pieces are acceptable.

Duration: Minimum 20 minutes, maximum 25 minutes

Notes:

- 1. All participants must play from memory in the order from A to B.
- 2. Pieces selected must not be from the same composer.
